By 8.00 o'clock in the morning, all the students from 6 secondary schools around Kota Marudu were already there. Invited guests started arriving by 9.00 a.m. and the community hall was soon filled. Our District Governor, First Lady and Assistant Governor were also present as well as the Presidents of the different Rotary clubs around Kota Kinabalu.

This year's SINDEX promises to be bigger than ever with a lot of support from the Malaysian Government, Universiti Malaysia Sabah, Shell and other corporate bodies.

The motivation talks will soon begin in earnest, involving all the Rotary clubs throughout Sabah. The competition this year is expected to be especially exciting as the winners may get a chance to take part in the national level competition in Kuala Lumpur where they will get a chance to compete at the international level. In September this year, there will also be an ASEAN Invention competition and exhibition in Labuan.

The whole project is going to cost in excess of RM200,000.00 and it is hoped that the students will exercise all their creativity.

I take this opportunity to thank our SINDEX Organising Chairman PP Philip Chong for organising the launch. It was well attended with about 700 students and many invited guests.
