PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE



Yesterday, the United Nations celebrated the World Water Day. UN Secretary General Ban Ki-moon, in his message to mark the World Water Day, said that more people die from unsafe water than from all forms of violence, including war. “These deaths are an affront to our common humanity, and undermine the efforts of many countries to achieve their development potential. Day after day, we pour millions of tons of untreated sewage and industrial and agricultural wastes into the world’s water systems.” He also noted that clean water has become scarce and would be even scarcer as a result of climate change.

Last weekend, our Club carried out the Commissioning of our Gravity Water Feed project at Kg. Timbangoh Laut (Phase I) as well as launching the Sanitation project (Phase II).

The occasion was well attended by Rotarians and the villagers. Our Guest of Honour, Datuk Tan Sri Bernard Dompok spoke about the importance of clean water. Clean water promotes good health and this in turn results in higher productivity. He complimented our club for our efforts in bringing clean water to the village. He spoke at length about the contributions of NGOs like the Rotary clubs and urged Rotarians to continue with their good work.

Phase II of our project will commence shortly and I would like to thank all our Partners in Service, in particular CIMB Bank and Bluescope Lysaght. I also take this opportunity to thank all Rotarians who have contributed so much of their time and effort to ensure the success of this worthwhile project.

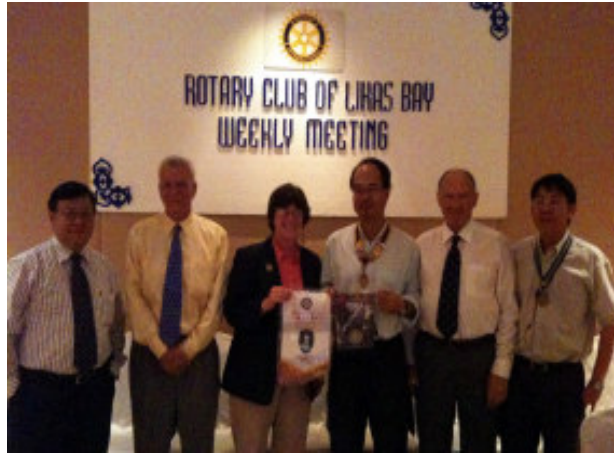
