In 2006/2007, she came back and started a bakery shop. After one year, she decided to venture a new business. She has set up

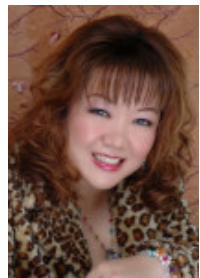
a new company supplying school materials for the subject "Kemahiran Hidup". The name of her company is Kesetia Enterprise.
